A Stock Exchange for Social Good?

India's Social Stock Exchange (SSE) is a platform which connects impact-driven investors with nonprofits and social enterprises tackling critical social challenges.





Why This Matters?

The usual funding models **need to evolve** because:

- **Short-term donations** don't scale
- **Unstable grants with little transparency**
- **Lack of investor trust** in social impact tracking

India's SSE ensures:

- **Long-term funding** for high-impact projects
- **Credibility & accountability** through strict reporting
- **Investor confidence** in measurable **social returns**

Who Can Join?

To be eligible, a social enterprise (NPO or FPE) must:

- Allocate at least **67% of its revenue, expenditure, or beneficiary base** to activities benefiting underserved or underprivileged communities
- Focus on sectors such as **healthcare, education, livelihood generation, gender equality, environmental sustainability, and financial inclusion**
- Demonstrate measurable, positive social impact through **transparent reporting**





How Does It Work?

- Nonprofits can raise funds via **impact bonds & Zero-Coupon-Zero-Principal (ZCZP) bonds**
- For-Profit Enterprises (FPEs) can issue **debt & equity investments**
- Why It's Different? A structured platform ensuring **transparency & accountability**
