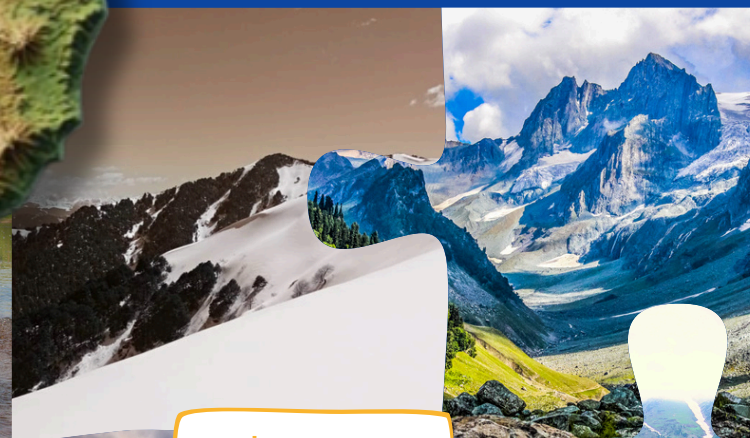
## A Place-Based Approach to India's Climate Transition

## CHALLENGES

A uniform national plan risks leaving regions behind






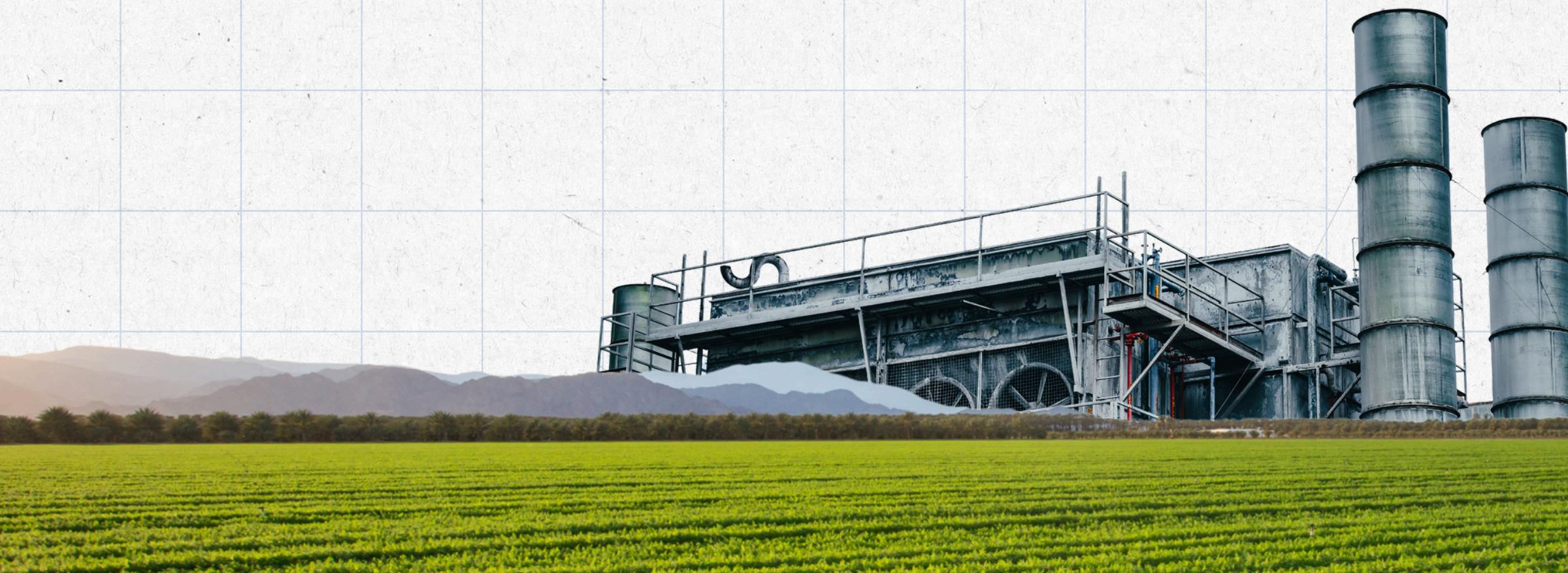


## What is place based transition?

A place-based approach means grounding climate action in local context — addressing each region's unique risks, resources, and opportunities.

Examples of Place-Based Climate Action:

-  **Agriculture** → Climate-resilient crops in drought-prone regions
-  **Industries** → Decarbonisation in manufacturing hubs
-  **Adaptation** → Flood defences in coastal and riverine states





## Place-based Climate Action

- **Kerala:** Resilient infrastructure for flood-prone communities
- **Tamil Nadu:** Greener supply chains for industry
- **Palli, J&K:** A Gram Panchayat powered by solar

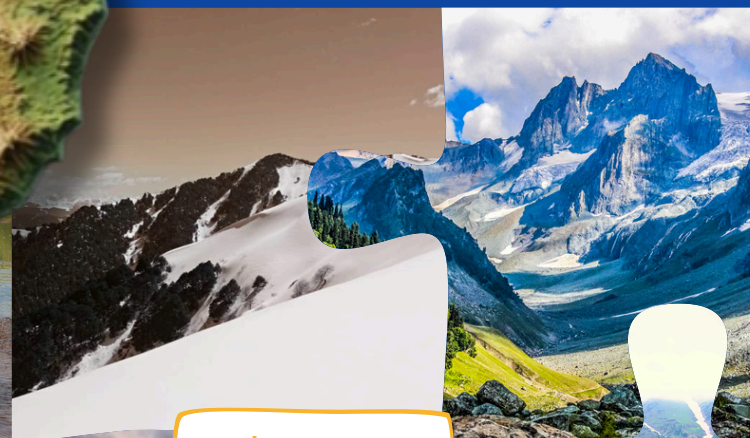
